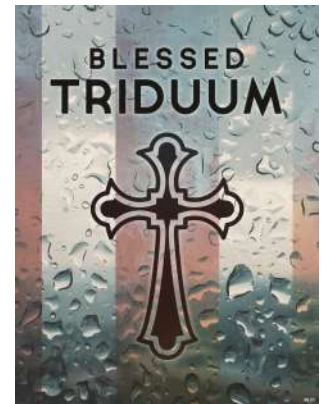

GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION

PASCHAL TRIDUUM

Christ redeemed us all and gave perfect glory to God principally through his paschal mystery. The Easter Triduum of the passion and resurrection of Christ is the culmination of the entire liturgical year. Thus the solemnity of Easter has the same kind of preeminence in the liturgical year that Sunday has in the week. The Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, reaches its high point in the Easter Vigil, and closes with evening prayer on Easter Sunday.

RECONCILIATION MONDAY

March 30th is Reconciliation Monday. Experience the liberating grace of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance). Confessions will be heard on March 30th from 3-9PM at Our Lady of Poland and many parishes in the Diocese of Rockville Centre, the Diocese of Brooklyn and the Archdiocese of New York. See the Holy Week Schedule for additional confession times before Easter. You may find in the vestibule of the church, brochures entitled, “Examination of Conscience for Adult and Teens” which contains the steps on how to go to Confession, as well as the Act of Contrition and a Prayer after Confession. Feel free to take one to assist you with your confession. Note: The confessional at Our Lady of Poland is now handicapped accessible and has been updated to meet Diocesan and ADA standards.

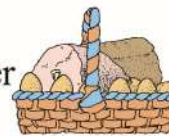

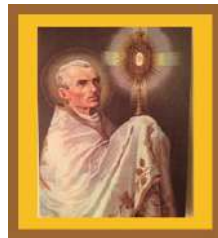

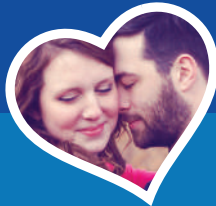
