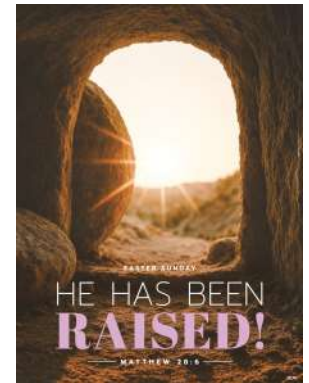

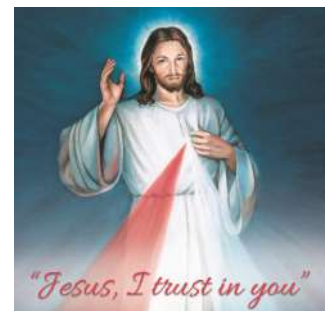

**BLESSING OF HOME FOR EASTER**

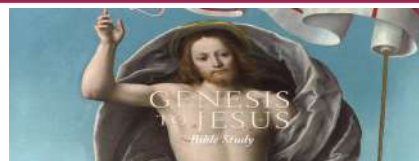
You are encouraged to use your holy water bottles and bless your home, family, and property. There will be Holy Water bottles available in the church.

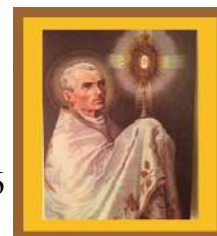

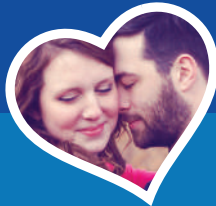
