Please join us every Wednesday after the daily 7:30AM Mass from 8AM - 10AM for Eucharistic Adoration.

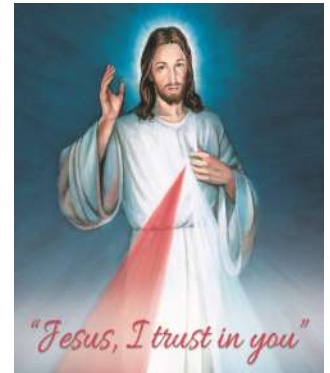

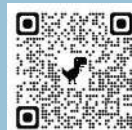

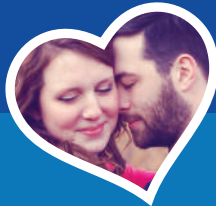
