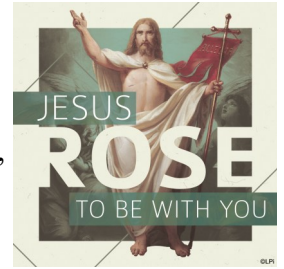

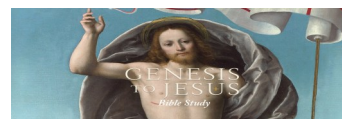

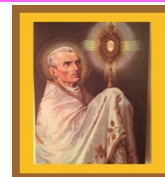


### THANK YOU

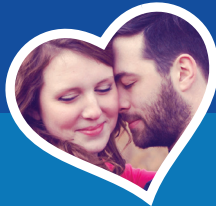
